Laurens Public Library Goals and Objectives July 2004 – June 2007

GOAL 1—Current Topics and Titles

Residents of the Laurens area will have access to current and popular materials to make their leisure time more productive and enjoyable.

- 1.1 Maintain at least 75% of fiction titles listed on the New York Times Bestseller List
- 1.2 Maintain at least 50% of nonfiction titles listed on the New York Times Bestseller List
- 1.3 Increase CD audio books by 20-25% either through lease agreement or purchase

GOAL 2 - General Information

Residents of the Laurens area will have a dependable source of reliable answers to reference questions and the assistance they need to make good decisions.

- 2.1 Selected Dewey areas of print reference materials will be surveyed for currency in each year
- 2.2 Conduct patron one-on-one Internet training hours at least once a month

GOAL 3 - Local History and Genealogy

Residents of the Laurens area will have resources available to support both genealogical and Laurens historical research.

- 3.1 Explore digitizing Laurens historical documents
- 3.2 Cooperate with Laurens Historical Commission in providing at least one Laurens history event/program for the community

Goal 4 - Curriculum Support for K-12 students

Students and teachers in the Laurens-Marathon Community School District will have access to ancillary resources necessary to attain educational goals.

- 4.1 Maintain an updated bibliographic file for teachers requesting additional resources for curriculum content
- 4.2 Develop a "Using the Library" workbook for lower elementary grades to use in the classroom or during "brown bag" sessions

Goal 5 - Lifelong Learning

Residents of the Laurens area will have the information, resources and assistance they need to achieve success in their personal independent learning.

5.1 Establish methods for connecting library services to private in-home day-care providers

5.2 Promote "Lifelong Llearning @ your library" monthly discussion group

Goal 6 - Building Community

Residents of Laurens will have to opportunity for interaction and participation in community activities.

- 6.1 Sponsor at least two programs a year featuring Laurens business/organization connections.
- 6.2 Continue to act as a clearing house for posting articles and events to the Laurens web page
- 6.3 Develop and maintain a new web page for the library

Goal 7 - Building/Equipment

Residents of the Laurens area will be proud of the library building and up-to-date equipment available at the library.

- 7.1 Establish a handicap parking place and have curb cuts made for easier access to library building
- 7.2 Determine need for a new roof or roof repair on library building
- 7.3 Upgrade at least one staff computer in the next three years
